Amended Council Meeting of April 7, 2010**

The Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Dean at 7:00 p.m. the following Council members were present: Ted Cavanaugh, Greg Garrett, Ron Lusher, Kristie Cavalier, Tom Cavalier, and Council President Pat Kennedy

The Pledge of Allegiance was performed.

Michael Maloney and Mary Workman were at the meeting to give Council and audience an overview of the financial status of Cloverleaf school system.

MINUTES: The minutes of the March 3, 2010 was presented after review Ron Lusher made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Pat Kennedy with all Council members voting "aye". Motion carried 6-0.

TREASURER'S REPORT: The treasurer's report for the month ending March 31, 2010 was presented, after review a motion to approve was made by Ron Lusher, seconded by Pat Kennedy with all Council members voting "aye". Motion carried 6-0.

LIST OF BILLS: The list of bills was presented, after review a motion to pay the bills was made by Ted Cavanaugh, seconded by Ron Lusher with all Council members voting "aye". Motion carried 6-0.

CLERK'S REPORT: Received paperwork form county treasurer to apply for taxes paid on fema properties purchased in the first phase of buyouts.

MAYOR'S REPORT: JOHN DEAN : Officers worked a total of 31 hours last month. Officer Hereda worked a total of 27 hours and Officer Schmoll worked 4 in March and 4 unreported hours in February. We received \$24.00 from Wadsworth Court this month. Officer Hereda will be off work for at least 4 weeks due to surgery. Mayor and Officer Hereda applied for a grant for a new police bike. Mayor attended a fire committee meeting on 3/10/2010 with Westfield fire to put together a job description for a new fire chief. Jeff VanLoon with the soil and water association invited someone from council to participate on the upper Chippewa creek water balanced growth association initiative.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT: ALAN MICHELSON: Two cases reported on this month. Alan also attended the fire contract meeting.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

HEALTH & SAFETY: PAT KENNEDY: It is time to renew the mosquito spray contract. Mr. Morehead from G & O Spray sold the business to Valley view Spray and will be working with him for a period of time and the rates would be the same. Pat Kennedy made a motion to contract with Valley view Spray at a rate of \$150 per application and \$350 for each larvicide application, seconded by Ron Lusher. with all Council members voting "aye". Motion carried 6-0.

ROADS: TOM CAVALIER: Put in a call to Performance Asphalt to get estimates on repairing the roads.

FINANCE: TED CAVANAUGH: Three properties could be eligible for the neighborhood stabilization program. Patrice from Medina County Planning will be contacting the property owners.

PROPERTIES: KRISTEN CAVALIER: One rental this month. Due to the added expense of the kitchen and food service licenses, Tom Cavalier made a motion to raise the rental of the town hall from \$50.00 to \$75.00, seconded by Ted Cavanaugh. Tom put old cabinets that were taken from the kitchen up in the main part of the hall. A counter top needs to be purchased, Tom made a motion to spend up to \$100 on a countertop, seconded by Ted Cavanaugh with all council members voting "aye". Motion carried 6-0. A motion detector will be put on garage. Ted made a motion to purchase window blinds for the hall, seconded by Tom.

SIGNS: GREG GARRETT: Worked on maintaining signs after winter damage.

UTILITIES: RON LUSHER: Removed some hanging wires throughout the Village. Gas company disconnected service on lower portion of Twilight Trail where our new park area is planned.

OLD BUSINESS: Mayor Dean discussed putting together a flyer to educate residents on electric aggregate that will be on the May ballot. Pat attended a fire district meeting, and reported to Council that no decisions have been made regarding the full time chief and other staffing. Also discussed was the possibility of soft billing for calls. Pat suggests that we shouldn't make any decisions until we get a contract to review.

NEW BUSINESS: Discussion of purchasing photos in the town hall..

AUDIENCE: Mike Stallard asked to bid on the lawn maintenance contract, but GPS has already been awarded the contract this year. Mike was asked to submit again next year. Linda Pavalick informed Council that CAUV applications are open through 4/19/10 and there is a regional pet adoption on May 1, 2010.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Greg Garrett and was seconded by Tom Cavalier with all Council members voting "aye". Motion carried 6-0
