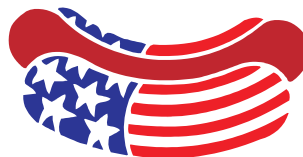
The Association will be issuing at a cost of \$5.00 each

IMPORTANT! Beach Rules and Regulations:

- No boats or jetskis are permitted in the swimming area. **OR LOADING AND UNLOADING PASSENGERS FROM THE SWIMMING AREA. BOATS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO FUEL, PARK OR BE WITHIN 300 FT OF THE SWIMMING AREA FOR SAFETY AND HEALTH PURPOSES - THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** Floating mattresses, childrens floats and playboats are permitted.
- **THIS IS A "FAMILY LAKEFRONT"** therefore, there will **NO TOLERANCE** of **Flagrant profanity, rowdiness, failure to obey the rules or disregard for beach attendant** will result in dismissal from the beach **IMMEDIATELY FOR THE DAY or LONGER.**
- **NO FISHING** (obvious reason - bare feet - hooks)will be permitted from the beach and we all **LOVE OUR ANIMALS BUT** - no dogs, cats or any animals are permitted in the fenced in portion of the lakefront - there is plenty of open area to spend with your pets outside of this one area. **ALSO** remember, the Village has a ordinance about cleaning up after your animal - so bring your bag or use one provide and please help.
